Directions

Directions From the Capitol Beltway (VA) exit Route 193 West (Georgetown Pike) Continue on Route 193 west for 2.3 miles to Madeira School entrance on right. It is preceded by a long stretch white fence on the right. There is a large new school 25 mph caution sign before the entrance. Bellview Road intersects Georgetown Pike from the left where you should turn right. If you reach Towleston Road (on left), you have gone too far.

After turning right, proceed down main entrance road to the security gate. Advise the guard of the PVS event you are attending. After the gate proceed past the tennis courts on both sides of the road.. The first big building (red brick) on the left is the Hurd Sports Center which contains the pool. Continue past the Sports Center and follow signs for visitor parking. Walk back to the pool.
