Re: Discounted USMS fees

The fee for swimmers to join USMS from September 1 through October 31 is reduced to \$27.00. This registration will be valid through December 31, 2008. You may red-line existing registration forms to show the reduced price. Note the form posted online indicates the reduced price in the fine print at the bottom (www.pvmasters.org/pvreg.pdf) and for those who register online, the new fee will be shown when the swimmer registers. To register online, please visit the PV website.

If any swimmer at practice is not a member of USMS then the liability insurance for ALL swimmers in the pool is invalidated (exception: USA Swimming registered athletes may be in the pool as long as the coach is a USA Swimming certified coach). It is very important that all swimmers participating in practice and competitions be members of USMS. Furthermore the coach must either be a registered USMS member or a certified USA Swimming coach for the full liability coverage.

Please note the last PV-LMSC Board Meeting of the year will be at the conclusion of the Sprint Classic at GMU on October 26, 2008. Meeting start time will be announced closer to the meeting.

PV-LMSC by-laws require attendance to at least one board meeting each year (the penalty is an increased 2009 club renewal fee). Since we are a non-profit organization we would appreciate your participation much more than penalty fee revenue. The following teams have not yet met the attendance requirement this year:
