



The Capitol Sea Devils Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent of a swimmer and member of The Capitol Sea Devils, I will abide by the following guidelines (please initial each):

- I have reviewed and will abide by the USA Safe Sport Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy.
- I will practice teamwork with all parents, swimmers, and coaches by supporting the values of Discipline, Loyalty, Commitment, and Hard Work.
- I will reinforce the principles of good sportsmanship, respect, and the overall vision and mission of The Capitol Sea Devils with my swimmer. I will support the coaches in efforts to ensure these standards are met during practices and meets.
- I will not coach or instruct the team or any swimmer at a practice or meets (from the stands or any other area) or interfere with coaches on the pool deck.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship by conducting myself in a manner that earns the respect of my child, other swimmers, parents, officials, and the coaches at meets and practices.
- I will maintain self-control at all times and know my role.
- I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials and/or any participating swimmer will not be permitted or tolerated.
- I will enjoy involvement with The Capitol Sea Devils by supporting the swimmers, coaches, and other parents with positive communication and actions.
- During competitions, questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials will be directed to a member of our coaching staff. Parents will address officials via the coaching staff only.
- I understand that the pools in which The Capitol Sea Devils practice may from time to time change our training schedule or have certain days during the season in which we cannot use the pool. These dates are factored into the overall fees for the season.
- I understand the terms of The Capitol Sea Devils Refund Policy as stated below.

Refund policy:

- If I register my swimmer prior to attending a placement evaluation session and my swimmer does not meet the minimum skills requirements, I may request a full refund for registration in the clinic program or a full refund less \$150 for competitive programs.
- If I withdraw my swimmer prior to the start of the program, I will forfeit my non-refundable swimmer deposit.
- Withdrawal within the first two weeks, I will forfeit my non-refundable deposit and 20% of the tuition.
- Withdrawal within the 3rd or 4th week, I will forfeit my non-refundable deposit and 50% of the tuition. All requests for refunds must be done in writing.
I understand that after the first month of the program there are NO refunds.
- I understand that “No Swim” or “Black-Out” dates are part of the rental agreement with our training sites. These dates are factored into the overall registration cost and are not subject to a refund.

I understand the above expectations and that my failure to adhere to them may result in disciplinary action.
